### MEMBERSHIP RIGHTS AND VOTING PROCEDURES

- (i) Each Registered Member shall have one vote on each question arising at any special or general meeting of the members.
- (ii) Registered Members shall designate their voting delegates prior to the Annual General Meeting by issuing an authorization. A Registered Member may appoint as their delegate an individual who shall be a member of the Registered Member Association to attend and act at the meeting on behalf of the Registered Member.
