This notice is a reminder of the requirements for the 2018 CRC that will be valid for all head coaches and assistant coaches in the U16, U19 and NRL divisions who have completed their CI Certification before May 2017. Certified Competition – Introduction coaches attending CRC will be required to complete 1 Competition- Development multi-sport module during the season.

Respect in Sport:

Ringette Canada has pledged its commitment to the Responsible Coaching Movement, which requires Respect in Sport training. Starting in 2018, all head coaches and assistant coaches attending CRC in the U16, U19 and NRL divisions will be required to have completed the Respect in Sport training.
