Tournament Classification Explanation

Shot Clock

- Shot clock will be used for U12 and higher divisions

There are three (3) types of classification. You **MUST** check one of the following: Female Only, Male Only and Co-ed.

Female Only

In a tournament, a division and level of play that is classified as Female Only consists of teams comprised solely of female players.

Male Only

In a tournament, a division and level of play that is classified as Male Only consists of teams comprised solely of male players.

Co-ed (All U12 Regional and Below Divisions must be Co-ed)

In a tournament, a division and level of play that is classified as Co-ed consists of teams comprised of both male and female players. To date, a team in a tournament has a maximum of 11 players per team (9 skaters and 2 goalies), a team is considered a Co-ed team should it have one (1) player with a different gender on its roster (i.e.: 09 player team with 1 male and 8 females or 1 female and 8 males).

In a tournament, a division and level of play that is classified as Co-ed may consist of teams from any two or more of the above classifications. For example, there are 4 teams in a Co-ed division/level of play: 1 Male Only team, 2 Female Only and 1 Co-ed, or, there are 3 Female Only teams and 1 Co-ed team.

“What happens if the U14B division is classified as Female Only and a team with 2 boys on it applies to enter?” There are 2 things that can be done: either disallow the Co-ed team from entering or inform the other teams that a Co-ed team wishes to enter, giving them the right to pull out of the tournament. Should the teams agree to let the Co-ed team participate, the tournament organizers inform their Regional G&T Coordinator that the classification will change from Female Only to Co-ed.
